He will then provide you will a form to be completed and returned along with a letter of application which should explain why you are interested in applying and any relevant experience you think you can bring to the role of Parish Councillor and providing some information regarding yourself.

Applications should reach the Clerk by 21st November 2021 and will be considered at the Council meeting on 22nd November 2021.
